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# Preparation for excavation

- Use of sunscreen

- Instruction about the right excavation
  - → layer by layer
  - → only take the find out when it's completely uncovered
  - → be careful with the find

# Excavation

1. calibrate the pit with a measuring tape
2. describe the first layer and documentate it  
on a paper (e.g. size, colour, quality)
3. dig the different layers seperately until finding  
something and documentated it
4. meanwhile shake the excluded earth in a  
special filter
5. be careful with the findings and clean it with a  
brush

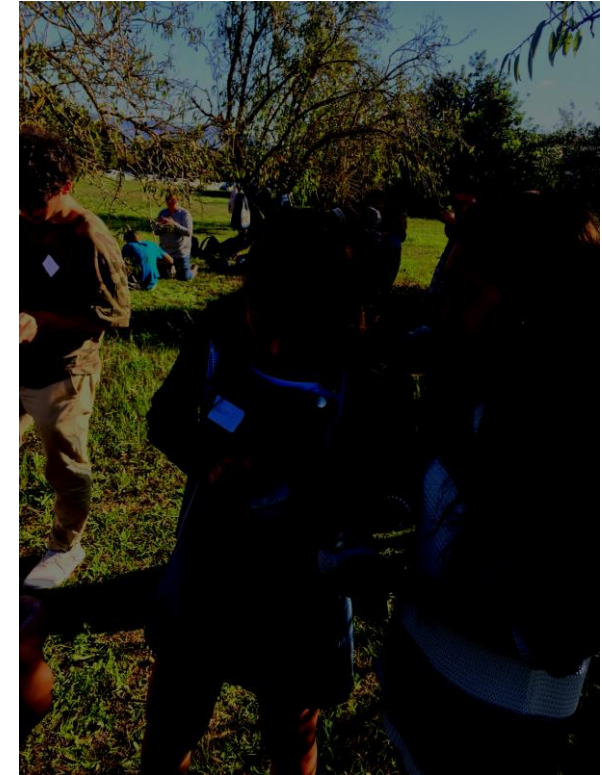
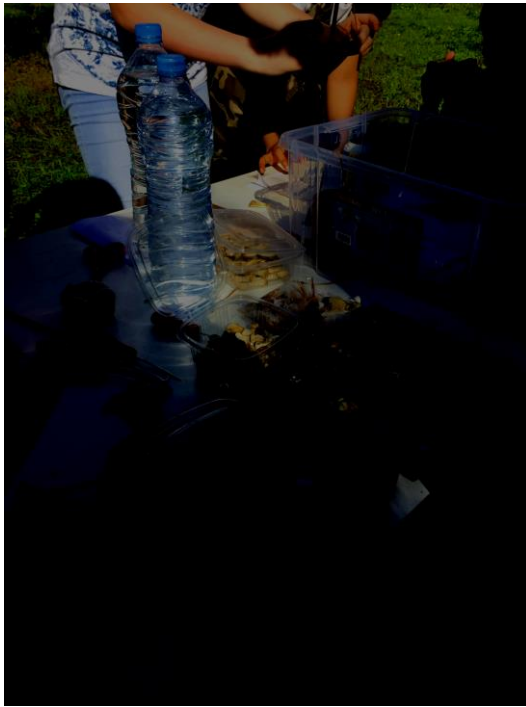
# Preparation for part 2

# Old-fashioned jewellery

1. take a bone & break it apart
2. drag the bone to get a sharp ending
3. drill a hole through the bone
4. thread the bone with things you like (e.g. pearls, shells, feathers...) on a cord
5. create a necklace, a bracelet or a key chain

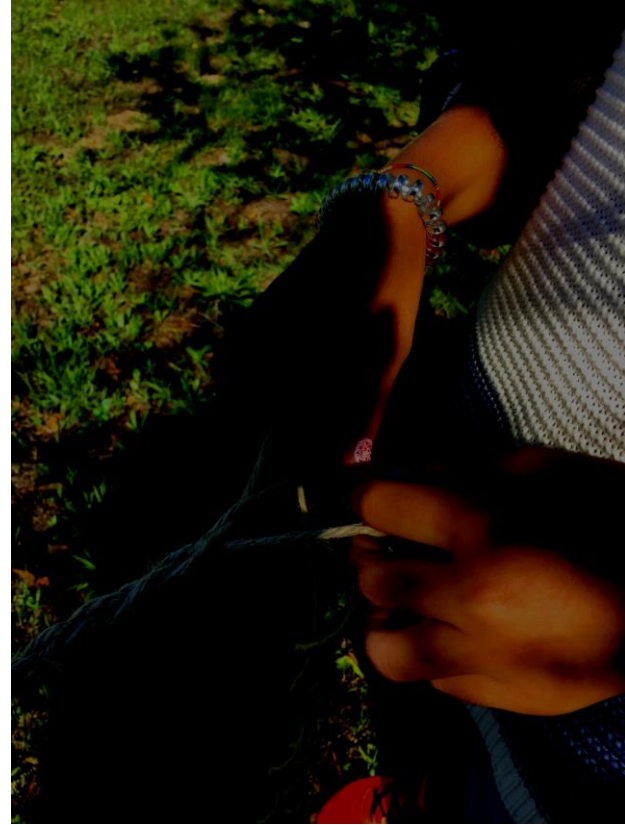
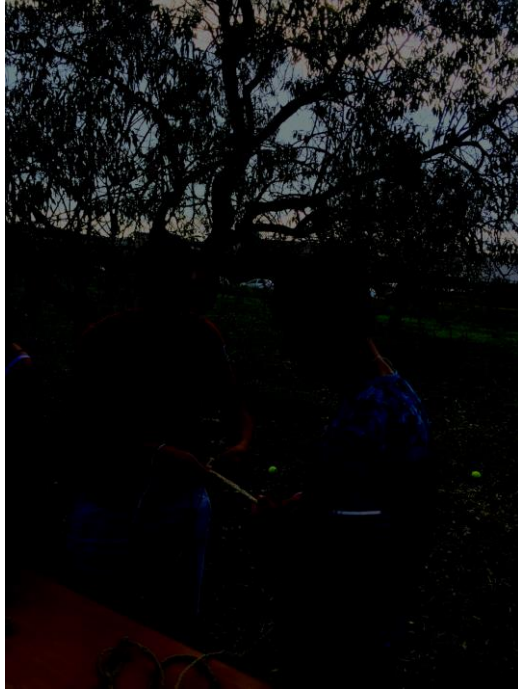


# Slingshot
